- **#** Identify Hazards & Exposures
- **■** Review Accident Reports and any Supervisor Investigations
- **#** Analyze Causes
- **♯** Recommend Corrections
- Report Findings at Managers/Staff Meetings


What the Committee Doesn't Do?


- **♯** Assign blame for accidents
- **■** Speculate about fraud or ill intent
- **♯** Gossip about committee business or findings
- **♯** Some if not all of the information discussed by the committee may be protected health information and protected by law.

The most effective safety committees play the role of a


Coach not a Cop





Keys to Effective Committee Meetings?

- **#** Organization
- **♯** Committee Understands Role & Purpose
- # Accidents Are Reviewed One at a Time



It takes a <u>hazard</u> and someone <u>exposed</u> to the hazard to produce an <u>accident</u>.

Hazard + Exposure ⇒ Accident

What Causes an Accident?

- **★**Conditions account for 3% of all workplace accidents.
- **Behaviors** (Acts) account for 95% of all workplace accidents.
- Uncontrollable Acts account for 2% of all workplace accidents.

What are we Looking to Report?

- Vague description of the Accident, including how it Happened.
- Why the Accident Happened. (Root Cause and Contributing Factors.)
- **♯** How it could have been Prevented.
- **■** Recommend Corrections to Prevent Similar Accidents in the Future.

General Format

- **■** Meetings to be held monthly.
- **♯** All Inclusive Membership
 - At least 3, no more than 8.
- **♯** Drawings are random in nature.
 - \$25 for committee participation
 - \$50 for suggestion submittal
- **♯** For a suggestion to qualify, it needs to be actionable.
