

# Irving ISD Night School Program 2011

**I. Student Enrollment**—The Irving ISD Night School Program serves students in grades 9 -12. The following categories of students have been identified as potential candidates for this program:

1. Returning students completing diploma requirements.
2. Seniors lacking sufficient credits to complete graduation requirements by the end of the school year.
3. Students in grades 9-12 who are not on track to graduate with their peers due to previous course failures.
4. Students in grades 9-11 seeking early graduation.

**II. Course Offerings**—Courses in language arts, math, science, social studies, and certain electives will be offered to students. The night school staff anticipates enrollment of 20 students with a minimum of 12 needed to offer a class. The following courses **may** be offered in night school.

**III. Funding**—The IISD Night School program will be tuition based.

IISD Students:                      \$140 per ½ credit      \$280 per 1 credit

Out of District Students:      \$200 per ½ credit      \$400 per 1 credit

**IV. Rules and Regulations**—Students enrolled in night school will follow the same rules and regulations as required in the Irving ISD Student Code of Conduct. Students will be withdrawn from class for violations of the attendance or disciplinary rules of the night school program. **Students are allowed one absence (includes excused absences) per ½ credit.** Upon the **third absence**, a student may be withdrawn without refund/course credit.

**V. Night School Calendar— 2011 School Year-- Classes will meet Monday and Thursday evenings, 4:30 – 9:00pm except on days designated as student holidays by the regular IISD school calendar.**

Registration will be January 25 – 26, 2011 from 4:30 – 6:00 pm at the Barbara Cardwell Career Preparatory Center, 101 E Union Bower Rd.

**Classes begin Monday January 31 and end May 9, 2011.**
