QUALIFICATIONS

1. Trade and Industrial Education Certification*
2. Current licensure by a state/nationally recognized accrediting agency as a professional practitioner in one or more approved occupations for which instruction is offered + one of the following options:
Option 1: Bachelor's degree + 3 years full-time experience (within the past 8 years) in construction or civil engineering
Option 2: Associates' degree + 3 years full-time experience (within the last 8 years) in construction or civil engineering
3. Successful completion of an approved educator preparation program and state exam for Trades and Industrial Education.
4. Ability to provide classroom instruction in applied academics and the basic concepts and necessary skills for employment in the construction industry.
5. Teach basic technical skills in multiple aspects of the industry including: HVAC; Bricklaying and masonry; carpentry; electrical trades; painting; plumbing, safety, project management and blueprints and specs.
6. Minimum 3 years full-time experience in Construction related industry, Civil Engineering, Construction Management.

* Qualified candidate can be hired as a teacher while working toward teaching certification at the same time.

GENERAL PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Develop and implement lesson plans which include classroom and lab instructional activities
2. Train students on use of equipment used in the construction industry including: use of standard tools; use of power tools, including hazardous equipment such as power saws, welding equipment, nail guns, etc.
3. Present subject matter in accordance with TEA, board policy, administrative regulations and industry standards.
4. Teach and test safety to OSHA industry protocol standards (10 hour construction safety course which includes power tools and chemical safety)
5. Use appropriate technologies in the teaching/learning process
6. Prepare students for national competency exams.
7. Secure internship positions for 2nd year students
8. Make informal visits to student interns training sites and work with employers to improve performance and skill level of students
