## 2009-2010 District Awards for Teacher Excellence (DATE) Cycle 1 Year 2

Total Award: \$2,332,771

### Part 1 Funds 60% = \$1,401,191

Full-Time Elementary and Secondary Teachers of Record in Math, Language Arts, Science and/or Social Studies and Campus Principals

#### ELEMENTARY PROGRAM

##### Eligible Elementary Teachers

*MUST MEET EVERY CRITERIA LISTED*

- An educator who teaches  $\geq 4$  hrs average per day
- Teacher of record in math, language arts, science and/or social studies for students in grades 3 through 5
- Employed by Irving ISD no later than Oct 30, 2009 and must remain continuously employed through the last day of duty in the 2009-2010 school year

##### 1a - Elementary Criteria

An elementary campus meets or exceeds the following criteria on the TAKS assessment combining results for the "October subset" of students in grades 3 through 5 for "All Students" AND "Economically Disadvantaged" on the 2010 TAKS Administration

**READING  $\geq 80\%$  AND WRITING  $\geq 80\%$  AND MATH  $\geq 80\%$  OR SCIENCE  $\geq 80\%$**

#### SECONDARY PROGRAM

##### Eligible Secondary Teachers

*MUST MEET EVERY CRITERIA LISTED*

- An educator who teaches  $\geq 4$  hrs average per day
- Teacher of record for at least one instructional period in math, language arts, science and/or social studies for students in grades 6 through 12
- Non-TAKS grade levels in math, English, reading, science, or social studies in grades 6-12 must show evidence in their lesson plans of teaming with TAKS grade level teachers in order to incorporate appropriate TAKS objectives into their curriculum
- Employed by Irving ISD no later than Oct 30, 2009 and must remain continuously employed through the last day of duty in the 2009-2010 school year

##### 1b - Middle School Criteria

A middle school campus meets or exceeds the following criteria on the TAKS assessment combining results for "All Students" and "Economically Disadvantaged" at all grades on the 2010 TAKS Administration

**MATHEMATICS  $\geq 75\%$   
READING  $\geq 90\%$   
WRITING  $\geq 93\%$   
SOCIAL STUDIES:  $\geq 93\%$   
SCIENCE  $\geq 70\%$**

##### 1c - High School Criteria

A secondary campus meets or exceeds the following criteria on the TAKS assessment combining results for "All Students" and "Economically Disadvantaged" at all grades on the 2010 TAKS Administration

**MATHEMATICS  $\geq 70\%$   
SCIENCE  $\geq 70\%$   
READING, LANGUAGE ARTS, WRITING  $\geq 90\%$   
(Reading, English, Humanities, Self-Contained ESL)  
SOCIAL STUDIES:  $\geq 90\%$**

**Award: \$1000\*** with Unawarded Part 1 Funds split equally among qualifying Part 1 participants.

### Part 2 Funds 40% = \$931,580

Groups of funds allocated to cover 2.1 Administrative Costs, 2.2 Special Campus Stipend, and 2.3 Recognized/Exemplary Stipends for Fully Certified Professional Staff Members **Not Awarded Under Part 1**

#### 2.1 ADMINISTRATIVE COSTS (<4%) = \$89,180

##### Eligible Employees

*MUST MEET EVERY CRITERIA LISTED*

- 2.1a Indirect Costs (2%) = \$46,655
- 2.1b Project Manager, Webmaster, Related Travel (<.5%) = \$10,525\*
- 2.1c DATE Committee Members (Campus Representatives)

##### Eligible Employees

*MUST MEET EVERY CRITERIA LISTED*

- An educator assigned/approved by DIC to be a voting member on DATE Committee
- Employed by Irving ISD no later than Oct 30, 2009 and must remain continuously employed through the last day of duty in the 2009-2010 school year

**Criteria:** -Must have attended  $\geq 75\%$  of the required DATE Committee Meetings

##### 2.1d DATE Campus Administrator

- Campus Principal who is responsible for communication, monitoring, verification, submission, and reporting duties as required by DATE Committee

**Criteria:** -Must have attended 100% of the required DATE implementation duties.

**2.1c and 2.1d Stipend: \$400\* Stipend**

Any funds not used for stipends shift to Part 2 awards

#### 2.2 SPECIAL CAMPUS STIPEND (<.5%) = \$11,200

##### Eligible Employees

*MUST MEET EVERY CRITERIA LISTED*

- An educator must be a full-time, fully certified professional staff member assigned to: Wheeler Center or Secondary Reassignment Center
- Employed by Irving ISD no later than Oct 30, 2009 and must remain continuously employed through the last day of duty in the 2009-2010 school year

**Criteria:** Must mentor one or more students for a minimum of 20 unpaid contact units AND Irving ISD's accountability rating, based on 2009-2010 data is "Recognized" or "Exemplary"

**2.2 Award: \$400\*** with unawarded Part 2 funds split equally among Part 2 awardees.

If District rating is < Recognized funds shift to Part 2 awards

#### 2.3 RECOGNIZED/EXEMPLARY CAMPUS STIPEND (>35%) = \$831,200

##### Eligible Employees

*MUST MEET EVERY CRITERIA LISTED*

- An educator must be a full-time, fully certified professional staff member assigned to an Early Childhood, Elementary, Middle School or High School campus in IISD
- Employed by Irving ISD no later than Oct 30, 2009 and must remain continuously employed through the last day of duty in the 2009-2010 school year

**Criteria:** Must be assigned to a campus with an accountability rating, based on 2009-2010 data, of "Recognized" or "Exemplary" AND mentor one or more students for a minimum of 20 unpaid contact units

**2.3 Award: \$400\*** with unawarded Part 2 funds split equally among qualifying Part 2 awardees.

\* All awards and stipends paid with DATE grant funds are subject to benefit deductions.
