Description of Services:

The Capitol Educational Support (CES) program provides one to one and small group tutoring to general education and special needs students in grades K-8. Capitol Educational Support's reading and math programs provide students with special needs as well as general education students customized instruction. The program includes individual attention and qualified teachers to help students improve their reading or math skills within an interactive and fun small group setting.

Description of Instructor Qualifications:

The staff of Capitol Educational Support meets all requirements for paraprofessionals under the No Child Left Behind Act of 2001. The CES administrative staff consists of certified teachers in both regular and special education areas. CES also has staff psychologists, social workers and master & doctorate level specialists in both math and reading areas. CES staff has extensive experience in curriculum design and educating special needs students. The CES staff is knowledgeable of all performance and content standards for each grade level and is able to make accommodations and modifications to the curriculum for any student requiring special needs.

Description of Evidence of Effectiveness:

In the school years 2003-2007, CES provided after school mathematics and reading instruction to over 500 students ranging in ages 5 to 19 in the District of Columbia. All students were assessed by a pre and post assessment provided by either the Wide Range Achievement Test 3 (WRAT3) or the Group Mathematics Assessment and Diagnostic Evaluation (GMADE) and the Group Reading Assessment and Diagnostic Evaluation (GRADE). CES tracked students' progress in math and reading. Students who received at least 52 hours of instruction demonstrated an average 34% grade equivalent (g.e.) increase in mathematics scores and a 31% grade equivalent (g.e.) increase reading scores. CES provided services in 53 D.C. Public Schools and received an above average rating by the District of Columbia Public School Local Educational Agency for its Supplemental Educational Services (SES) program.
