Description of Services:

E.nopi MATH is a flexible, individualized self-learning program that provides a systematic and progressive approach to improving learning in math. The E.nopi MATH program is designed to encourage analytical and critical thinking skills in Preschool – 10th grade students. E.nopi MATH program has been created to provide instruction in areas of mathematics which include Numbers, Algebra, Functions, Patterns, Measurement, Geometry, Statistics, Reasoning and Data Analysis. These subject areas begin with the preschool level and end with the high school levels.

E.nopi ENGLISH is an individualized self-learning program that provides a systematic and progressive approach that improves learning in English-Language arts.

E.nopi ENGLISH program has been created to provide instruction in specific areas of the English language. This includes the basic language art skills such as Building a Foundation in Phonics and Decoding for the Beginning Reader; Introduction to Basic Skills and Concepts, Beginning Text Analysis and Intensive Reading, Writing, and Vocabulary such as Advanced Comprehension Skills, Complex Text Analysis (character, setting, plot, conflict, resolution, point of view, etc), Learning to write fluently and proficiently in the five writing styles.

Description of Instructor Qualifications:

Daekyo America, Inc. will hire and train specific staff with qualifications to teach mathematics and/or English-language arts, or who are currently working with the E.nopi MATH and/or ENGLISH program. In order to do so, all current staff and prospective staff will be interviewed by Daekyo America, Inc. Prospective staff will be required to show proof of credentials by way of certificate as well as show proof of experience by completing an internal employee application as well as providing an individual resume. All current staff and potential staff will be chosen based on their experience and qualifications.

The job description for staff is:

- Staff must be responsible to work with students.
- Must tutor students using E.nopi MATH and E.nopi ENGLISH materials.
- Provide help to students to complete the material when needed.
- Communicate orally with parents/guardians about the progress of the student. Provide written comment of progress to Daekyo America, Inc. to be submitted to the School District and parents/guardians.

Description of Evidence of Effectiveness:

We have 2.5 million members over the world. This program has been extensively used for 30 years worldwide and then selected locations not only to supplement the curriculum at school, but also to help parents to support students to continue learning in the home environment. In a research study in California and New York, students who studied E.nopi MATH scored better in the state math standard test and math aptitude test than those who only studied with traditional textbooks. To show the effectiveness of the E.nopi ENGLISH program, a couple of schools were selected for pilot programs. The pilot program in Wilton Place El. School showed that students learned more about the subject which was English-Language art, considering that most of the students are Hispanic and for some, English was not their first language.
