

ART ADVANCED THREE – DIMENSIONAL

7th and 8th graders who have successfully completed Art – Design may enroll in this class. This course will provide an opportunity for the serious art student who enjoys working with three-dimensional media to develop advanced skill in sculpture, ceramics and other art forms. The refinement of concept and technique, and an application of the elements and principles of design to three-dimensional art will be encouraged. Students will create personally expressive works of art through an increasing sensitivity to what they see, know, feel, and imagine.

Students will learn that studying, creating, and enjoying art can become a life-long pursuit, and art-related careers will be explored. The concept that art is a living heritage will be reinforced through lessons involving the analysis and appreciation of American and international sculpture and three-dimensional crafts. Critiques and evaluations of their own and others' work will challenge students to think creatively and independently.

Art lessons will support District goals by reinforcing academic skills and assisting students in meeting grade-level expectations.
