

STUDENT ART SHOWS

Each spring Irving Independent School District sponsors an elementary, middle, and high school student art show. These shows are displayed in the Irving Arts Center Main Gallery. Each show opens with a reception for artists and teachers and features 100 or more works of two and three-dimensional art from each school. These shows are very special occasions and provide a spotlight for excellence in creative achievement.

Planning for this show from the beginning of the school year is a key to success for the middle school art teacher. Selecting and preparing work for display throughout the year assures that students from both semesters are well represented in the show. Teachers will find it advisable to store possible entries at school until after the show.

These shows are announced to parents by letters from the IISD Superintendent. These letters will be distributed to teachers through the Fine Arts Office. It is the teacher's responsibility to send these letters to parents in a timely manner.
