

## Final Goal Reflection

**As a very important addition to this last goal reflection, please respond to the following as well in your written self-reflection:**

1. As you reflect on the creation of the “QUEST CHEST,” the written self-reflections, and the symbols, what changes would you make to them now—if any—as you are older, wiser, and further along on meeting your goals/quest?
2. What does your response tell about ourselves and humanity and change?
3. Create a final symbol which represents your 6<sup>th</sup> grade-year quest.
