SUBSTITUTE TEACHER

BS Degree and Valid Teaching Certificate	\$70 per day
BS Degree and No Teaching Certificate	\$64 per day
No BS Degree	\$58 per day

CLINIC

BS Degree or RN Certificate	\$70 per day
No Certificate	\$58 per day

PARAPROFESSIONAL

All	\$55 per day
Cafeteria Aide (3 3/4 hours)	\$30 per day

CONSECUTIVE DAYS OF SERVICE

11th day in the same assignment	plus \$10 per day
21st day in the same assignment	plus \$5 per day

TOTAL DAYS OF SERVICE IN EACH SEMESTER

51st day (days do not have to be consecutive)	plus \$10 per day for remainder of semester
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In long term assignments extending over more than one six weeks grading period, or in other extenuating circumstances, a negotiated compensation rate not to exceed \$125 per day may be authorized by the administration. This rate may be effective from the first day of the assignment.

Substitutes who are required to work more than four hours per day will be compensated at the full daily rate. Those required to work four hours or less will be compensated for one-half of the day.

Teachers who voluntarily substitute during conference or planning time in situations where adequate numbers of regular substitutes are not available will be compensated at the rate of \$22 per hour.

In the event that other professionally certified personnel have a need that necessitates a long-term absence from duty, or in the case of a vacancy in such a position, the Superintendent or his designee shall establish a rate of compensation that is commensurate with the duties of the position and skills and training of the substitute, if a substitute is employed.

Substitutes increase their daily rate of compensation for teaching assignments by \$5 per day by completing prescribed district staff development activities as offered twice a year. Currently it is not necessary to repeat the activities.

This schedule applies to the 2002 - 2003 school year only.
