

IRVING ISD VICE/ASSISTANT PRINCIPAL SALARY SCHEDULE

2003 - 2004

Beginning September 1, 2003, eligible employees in TRS and working at least 30 hours per week will receive \$41.66/month for a benefit supplement not included in the Salary Schedule. For a period of 12 months, this would equate to \$500 in addition to IISD Salary for each eligible employee in TRS. (HB 3459) Full-time employees specifically excluded from the HB3459 benefit will be eligible for the District Off-Set Benefit of \$41.66/month.
