

## Bilingual/ESL Summer School 2009



A **Bilingual/ESL Summer School Program** will be offered to current *Pre-Kindergarten, Kindergarten, and First Grade Retainees who are Limited English Proficient (LEP) students*. This program will enhance early literacy and numeracy skills. The program is voluntary and free for LEP students who qualify. Breakfast and lunch will be provided. **Transportation will NOT be provided.**

### Curriculum

**Integration of Science and Literacy-** Science content will be used to develop literacy skills. Teachers will use the 5E model to involve students in hands-on learning experiences. The central focus of each lesson will be to introduce and extend science concepts and vocabulary through balanced literacy.

**Mathematics-** All students will receive basic numeracy instruction. Hands-on instruction will be expected through the use of manipulatives. **“The Summer Success Math Program”** will be the core math curriculum.

**Physical Activity-** Students will participate in fine and gross motor skill activities such as group games, organized outdoor play, etc. All activities will be preceded by a language lesson to enhance the vocabulary and activity understanding.

**Home-School Connection** Parents will be invited to attend a meeting where they will learn strategies that can be used at home to read with their children.
