Summer Enrichment Reading Camp Proposal
Irving Independent School District**

Program Description:

The Summer Enrichment Reading Camp will be held for 2 weeks at Paul Keyes Elementary. The instructional focus of the camp will be reading and writing enrichment through the study of relevant age appropriate thematic units. Elementary and middle school homeless students will be invited to participate through flyers and personal invitations to the domestic violence shelter and transitional living program.

Authentic activities will include field trips which will pertain to the unit of study, balanced literacy strategies, guest presentations by various agencies Salesmanship Club and therapy for at-risk students through expressive arts (contracted services include Young Audiences & City of Irving Parks and Recreation) Healthy choices such as goal setting, decision making and problem solving will be incorporated daily as part of the overall curriculum.
