Program Description:

As a 21st Century Community Learning Center, de Zavala Middle School will offer a Summer program with activities designed for both enrichment and remediation purposes.

The Summer F.I.E.S.T.A. Program will serve approximately 120 students. Certified teachers will provide 55 minutes of instruction daily in the general areas of Arts, Academics, and Athletics; students will have the option of selecting one class from each of these three areas. Academic time will focus on the core areas of Math, Science and Language Arts; Arts and Athletics will each include a variety of activities based upon student interest. In addition, special classes in the core subjects of Math, Science, and Language Arts will be held for students requiring remediation.
