Enrollment Sessions

Students and parents are instructed to arrive at 9:00 a.m. for enrollment sessions, after they have been contacted by DCJJAEP.

Both the parent and student must attend. This is the student's first day of school. The parent must present valid identification and emergency contact information.

***Note:** Orientations are only on Mondays and Thursdays at 9:00 a.m.



Required Uniform

- ❖ **White Polo Shirt**
(Tight fitting shirts, or shirts with logos are prohibited)
- ❖ **Only Brown or Black Belts**
- ❖ **Khaki Pants(Only long pants)**
(Tight fitting pants, no oversized pants, no sagging, capri, crop pants, jeans or corduroy, skirts are prohibited)
- ❖ **Only White socks**
- ❖ **White Tennis Shoes**
- Truancy petitions will be filed on students and parents/guardians of students who fail to enroll at DCJJAEP



Transportation

Students are placed on the bus route 5 to 10 days after the student's first day of school. Parents/Guardians are responsible for the student's transportation until their child is placed on a bus route.



Meals

All students will receive free lunch. Please do not send a lunch with your child on the first day.



School Supplies

Students will need to bring:

**Directions to Dallas County Juvenile
Justice Alternative Program**

FROM 1-35 (NORTH)

Take Inwood Rd. west, continue over the Trinity River and Inwood becomes Hampton Rd. Follow Hampton and turn right on West Commerce (at Light). Take an immediate left on Lone Star Dr. Go past the stop sign at Postal Way and turn right on Terre Colony Court. The DCJJAEP is on the northwest corner of Lone Star Dr. and Terre Colony Court.

FROM I-30

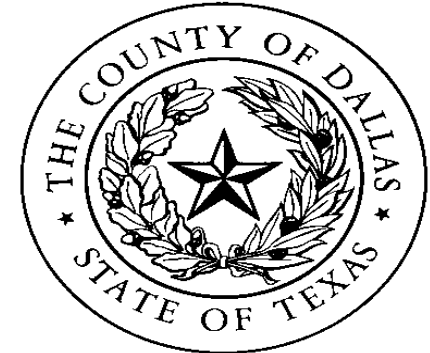
Take I-30 west (from Dallas) and take exit 41 (Westmorland exit), get in the right hand lane turn right at Terre Colony Court. Go past the stop sign at Lone star Drive, the DCJJAEP is on the northwest corner of Lone Star Drive and Terre Colony Court.
