

Reem's shapes around the world!



In this picture, I see

Rectangle a 3-D polygon that is like the cube but does not have all sides corresponding.
Prism

Cube a 3-D polygon with all its sides (4) corresponding and parallel to each other.

Sphere a 3-D closed round figure that has **NO** corresponding sides at all.

You can use a geometric shape when you go to a play place like Chuck E. Cheese. At Chuck E. Cheese, they have all sorts of games that include geometric shapes like a sphere for a basketball game, or a rectangular prism at the play place up on the roof where the kids go inside those shapes and play, and a cube for one of the games they have. (you enter a coin in and try to get 50 tickets!)
