

The Shapes of Mexico



In this picture I found circles, squares, rectangles and triangles.

- 1. Circle - A plane curve everywhere equidistant from a given fixed point, the center.**
- 2. Square - A plane figure having four equal sides.**
- 3. Rectangle - A four-sided plane figure with four right angles.**
- 4. Triangle - The plane figure formed by connecting three points not in a straight line by straight line segments; a three-sided polygon.**

I have a hobby where you really use geometric shapes all of the time. My hobby is scrap booking. This is where you take photos, cut them into shapes and then put them together. For example, I might cut out my photo in a small circle. I might then cut out a pretty colored sheet to be a larger circle. I would then tape the large circle to the paper and then put the smaller photo on top.
