HOUSE # 1 COSMETOLOGY

LICENSURE INFORMATION

10th: Introduction to Cosmetology (Offered in 2009-2010) afternoon class.

Shampoo and Conditioning Specialist:

Requires that 150 hours of instruction be completed in not less than 8 weeks from date of enrollment and students must be 17 years of age to license.

11th: Year 1—2 credits, evening class (Shampoo and Conditioning License)

12th: Year II—2 credits, evening class (Facialist or Manicurist License)

Manicurist:

Requires 600 hours of instruction and student must be 17 years of age to license.

Facialist:

Requires 750 hours of instruction and student must be 17 years of age to license.

This program is designed for students who will want to go to work immediately with certifications in specific areas such as Shampoo and Conditioning Specialist, Manicurist, and Facialist. These licenses can be obtained as you go and used for employment while a student is still in school.

COST:

The enrollment cost for the 2 year Cosmetology program is \$125.00 Permit fees must be paid prior to the first day of class. Once the student is issued a permit, they will be eligible to work (limited capacity) in a salon.
