Provisions for Singley Academy Enrollment 10th Grade Applicants must be in the 9th grade 2022 Cohort

1. Students must be eligible to attend Irving ISD schools at the time application to Singley Academy is submitted.
2. Only first-time ninth grade students qualify for entry in the lottery for a 10th grade slot at Singley Academy. Students must be on track to graduate with their state and federal graduation cohort to qualify for a 10th grade slot at Singley. Students who fail to complete all requirements for promotion to 10th grade will forfeit enrollment to Singley Academy.
3. The application deadlines will be strictly enforced. Applications submitted after the deadline will not be included in the lottery.
4. Deadlines for selected students to notify Singley Academy of acceptance will be strictly enforced. If a selected student fails to notify Singley Academy of their acceptance for enrollment by the indicated deadline, the student forfeits their seat, which will be offered to another student on the waiting list for Singley Academy.
5. Students selected for tenth-grade enrollment at Singley Academy in a Specialization area must remain in that Specialization for the remainder of their high school years.
6. **Students selected for 10th grade enrollment at Singley Academy must be “in attendance” on the first day of school.** Selected students absent on the first day of school will be dropped as “No Shows” as required by District attendance procedures. **No Show students** will forfeit their seat at Singley Academy, which will be offered to a student on the waiting list.
7. Parent(s) and student understand that once enrolled at Singley Academy, Singley becomes the student’s “home campus” instead of their zoned campus. The student shall remain enrolled at Singley Academy for the entire four-years of high school.
The parent must submit an in-District transfer request for the student to return to their zoned campus during the District transfer window.
8. **By signing and submitting this application and upon acceptance of the offer letter to enroll at Singley Academy,** parents and students agree to the above provisions.
