District Will Continue to Require Masks for All Staff and Students While on District Properties

Dear Irving ISD Staff,

In Irving ISD, the safety of our students and staff is our top priority. Consistent with the advice of health professionals, guidelines from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and recommendation from the Texas Education Agency, Irving ISD will continue to require all students and staff to wear masks on district property and at district events for the foreseeable future.
