



# Crockett Middle School Bell Schedule



Our campus recommendation is that students follow the bell schedule during remote learning. This will allow students to have live interactions with their teachers and get timely feedback. Students and families can still choose to work on another schedule that best suits their needs. However, teachers will be following the schedule below and there may be delays in feedback when work is completed outside of the school day.

In an effort to ensure all students are successful, we want to make sure each parent is aware of the **new remote learning attendance policy** for this year. Unlike last semester, students will receive credit by signing into the Canvas system on a daily basis.

**If students do not sign in on a daily basis they will be counted absent for that day.** The State of Texas will be holding students to the Compulsory Attendance Law; therefore, it is **important to ensure our students are actively engaged on a daily basis.**

Students must do one of the following:

1. Daily progress in the Canvas system, (for example: completing a short daily attendance assignment in Canvas for the purpose of taking attendance such as a quick write, an exit ticket, or bell-ringer); or
2. Daily progress via teacher-student interactions, as defined in the approved learning plan (for example: communication or participation in lecture); or
3. Completion/Turn-in of assignments from student to teacher - potentially via email, on-line, or mail

Grades will be based on the mastery level of the assignments. It will not be pass/fail, but an accurate reflection of the student's demonstration of learning.
