

Biking Safety and Skills Course Irving ISD Physical Education

Dear Parent/Guardian:

As part of our Safe Routes to School initiative, your child has the opportunity to participate in our *iBike* Safety and Skills Course in physical education. The goal of *iBike* is to give students authentic experiences in performing safe habits while riding bicycles, and provide them opportunities to practice the various skills required to safely navigate a bike throughout their environment. Student feedback indicates that they are very interested in biking safety, but many lack the knowledge and skills needed to travel on bicycles without incident. The *iBike* program will help bridge that gap between learning and competence. Bikes and bike helmets that meet the federal safety standards set by the Consumer Product Safety Commission will be provided by the district, however, students are welcome to bring their own bike and helmet to school for use in the skills course. Training wheels will also be available for those unaccustomed to riding a bike.

Parent/guardian permission is required for participation in the program, please sign the permission/information slip on the next page and return it to your child's physical education teacher by Monday, September 10. Students who do not have parent permission will participate in other biking safety activities during that time.


