- 1. Log into a Windows PC computer.
- 2. Once logged in, press CTRL+ALT+DELETE
- 3. Select "Change a password".



4. Enter your Old Password and New Password. The password must be at least 8 characters or more and meet 3 of the 4 following requirements: upper case letter, lower case letter, a numerical digit (0 thru 9), and/or a non-alphanumeric character (!@#\$).

- 5. Log out and log back in on the PC.
- 6. Now you need to open up your Macintosh computer/laptop. If your machine is on the domain, simply enter your login and new password.
- 7. If you Macintosh computer/laptop is not on the domain (most fall into this category), you need to click on the Wi-Fi icon in the top right corner and turn Wi-Fi off.



8. Next, Click on the "Turn Wi-Fi On".



9. When you turn the Wi-Fi back on, you will be prompted to enter your district login and new password associated with the network "IISD_WPA_P".
